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What are Private Physician Feedback Reports?


- Print or online reports that present performance information related to clinical quality/patient experience/resource use/productivity
- Objectives include:
 - □ Assess performance relative to peers and/or benchmarks
 - □ Motivate improvement efforts
 - □ Support patient care management
 - □ Provide access to improvement tools and resources

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Common Characteristics

- Granular level information
- Patient level information
- Review and correction capability
- Highlighting of priorities
- Timeliness of information
- Trending capability
